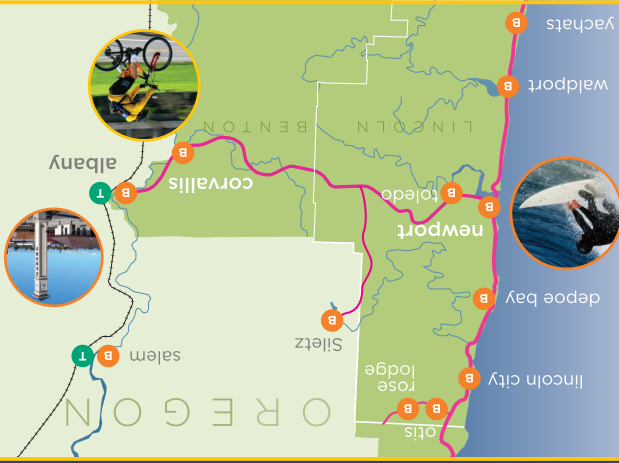

Plan Your Route: We can help you identify the most convenient bus stop(s) and routes. Please call: Lincoln County Transit at 541-265-4900.

Give Yourself Time: Get to the bus stop early to allow for minor schedule changes.

On-Call Stops: You must call the office to schedule the bus to pick you up at an on-call stop. Let the driver know if you want to get off at an on-call stop. On-call stops are designated with (\*) and asterisks.

Seatbelt use is required on all buses.

Children: Child restraint is the responsibility of each parent. A limited number of built-in child seats are provided. Parents are responsible for providing rear-facing seats for children that weigh less than 40 pounds or are under two years of age.

Safety: Drivers are authorized to use their discretion to refuse any stops that they feel may be unsafe, hazardous, inaccessible, or cause damage to vehicle. Use designated crosswalks after vehicle pulls away. Do not interfere with the movement of any transit vehicle.

No Service: Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day.

Carry Coupons, Pass, or Correct Change: Drivers cannot make change. Fares are low—you can save even more by purchasing ride coupon books or North by Northwest Connector Passes at the Lincoln County Transit Office or from any of our drivers by cash or check.

Ride coupons: Purchase all route coupons at Lincoln County Transit Office or from the driver. We do not accept credit or debit cards. To travel the coast, purchase individual North by Northwest Connector fares, or a 3-day or 7-day visitor pass.

Payment: All Passengers must pay fare or present coupon upon boarding.

## how to ride

### Passenger Assistance:

Drivers may leave bus to provide minimal assistance to passengers in boarding and de-boarding.

### Wheelchair Accessible:



- All vehicles are wheelchair accessible.
- Wheelchairs must be in an upright position for transport.
- All mobility devices must be secured to floor.
- Wheel mobility devices are given priority in the securement areas of the buses.

### Portable Oxygen:

It is our policy not to deny service to passengers using portable oxygen or respirators except where they fall under hazardous materials regulations.

### Pets:

All pets must be in an approved pet carrier. Service Animals are allowed as long as they are trained specifically to aid the owner and remain under owner's control.

### Bike racks:

Bike racks are available on most buses—first come, first served basis.

## rider etiquette

- Extinguish cigarettes before boarding bus.
- Practice good personal hygiene.
- Hazardous objects or weapons of any kind are prohibited on bus.
- For safety reasons, we cannot transport flammable, caustic, or poisonous materials.
- Finish food and beverage before boarding the bus, or keep them in a closed container.
- Do not bring open containers of alcohol or illegal or controlled substance on bus.
- Limit electronic devices to headphones that cannot be heard by the driver or other passengers.
- As a courtesy, turn off cell phones or turn ringer down and talk quietly.
- Adhere to "front of the bus" courtesy seating for the elderly and disabled.
- No bags of returnables, cans, or bottles allowed on the bus
- Be courteous to the driver and other passengers; verbal abuse, fighting, or physically threatening behavior will not be tolerated on any bus.
- No unnecessary conversation with the driver while the bus is moving.
- Remain seated while bus is in motion.
- Shoes and shirts must be worn; keep feet on floor.
- Vandalism is a crime. Violators will be prosecuted.
- We allow a maximum of four grocery sized bags per person on the bus.
- Do not leave items or packages on the bus while doing additional shopping or making additional stops.
- Carts, carriages and strollers must be folded prior to boarding and remain folded until after de-boarding the bus.
- You must conduct yourself in a manner that does not interfere with the safety and comfort of other passengers or driver. Disruptive behavior, profanity, or vulgar language may result in removal from the bus.**
